### GUIDELINES FOR PLAYER EVALUATIONS FOR THE 2005 SEASON

- 1) Players are evaluated and categorized by the coaches from all levels of play (A thru D)
- 2) Evaluations will be held at the Keller Fields
- 3) The coaches pick—All player assignments are final
- 4) All players must be present for the tryouts
- 5) League requirements of age and team classifications are as follows:

15 year olds must play A, D or Sr. Teener

14 year olds can play A, B, or D

13 year olds can play A, B, C, or D

15 year olds not making an A team must play D or Sr. Teener

14 year olds not making an A or B team must play D

13 year olds not making an A or B team must play C or D
